Axel Neiss from Kindenheim in the Pfalz, Jochen Dreissigacker from Bechtheim in Rheinhessen and Sebastian Oberbillig from Trier in the Mosel region are young, up-and-coming talented wine-makers who already enjoy popularity throughout Germany. They produce wines of a high standard, a fact which is recognized by reputable, international colleagues. All three have been included in the German Wine Guides Eichelmann & Gault Millau and have received very good ratings. They have been invited to present their wines at tastings held by regional associations of the VDP and can justifiably compare themselves to the top wine-makers in Germany.

Axel Neiss's wines have already made it to the Vatican and New York. Horst Köhler, the Federal President of Germany was recently served the *Cuvée N* at a reception there. Foreign Minister Steinmeier took some Riesling from the Neiss Wine Estate to a dinner at the United Nations in New York.

All three winemakers grew up on family wine estates and hence have the art of wine-making in their blood. For some time now they have been in charge of their parental enterprises. These young wine-growers are all renowned for their commitment to change. Hence older grape varieties have been replaced by new ones and labels have been redesigned and have a more modern appearance. Working methods in both the vineyards and cellars have been evaluated and modernized wherever deemed necessary.

They are also in regular contact with their colleagues. Jochen Dreissigacker for example is a member of the group „Message in a Bottle“ to which a good 15 other wine-growers in Rheinhessen, such as Phillip Wittmann and Carolin Gillot also belong.

Axel Neiss is actively involved in the „Arbeitskreis kontrolliert umweltschonender Weinbau Rheinland-Pfalz“ (Association for Controlled Ecological Viniculture) and is a member of the „Verein Junge Talente Pfalz“ (Association of Young Talents Pfalz). This association for aspiring wine-growers enjoys the guidance afforded by the VDP Pfalz.

They equally utilize experience acquired abroad. For example, Sebastian Oberbillig had to cope with two harvests in 2006. The first harvest he was involved in was in spring during a six-month period of vocational experience in New Zealand. However, with immediate effect he is concentrating on managing the family's wine estate.
