Effective 1st April 2010 the European Union started their new system called electronic Excise Movement and Control System, EMCS. This will replace the AAD document by 01st January 2011 at the latest.

We kindly ask all our partners within the European Union to contact their logistic partner and inform us about the status of e-AD within their companies.

Wineconsale will be ready to use the e-AD system within April or May. We would like to start as soon as possible.

Due to these (and other) new regulations it will become increasingly difficult for small and medium sized producers to export wine over the border of Germany.

During ProWein a growing trend was confirmed which was quite visible within 2009 already. White burgundy varieties both Weissburgunder and Grauburgunder are gaining more and more popularity among consumers in Germany. Producers like Neiss, Dreissigacker or Bassermann-Jordan face a rising demand from both on and off-trade for these wines. However, a small harvest in 2009 keeps availability limited and many wines will be sold out throughout the summer season.
